
COLOMBIA'S VULNERABLE COMMUNITIES

Since the 2016 peace agreement, armed and criminal groups are fighting to secure illicit revenues and territory by coercing rural populations through child recruitment, gender-based violence and movement restrictions.



FORCIBLY DISPLACED

Since 2016, the number of forcibly displaced persons has increased from 10,000 to **over 85,000.**



FORCIBLY CONFINED

Since 2017, the number of forcibly confined persons has increased from 1,400 to **119,000**.
