The Iran-U.S. Trigger List

Iraq/Washington 14 November

A U.S. official [confirmed](#) the extension by 120 days of a sanctions waiver that “will allow Iraq to use its own funds to render payment for Iranian electricity imports into restricted Iranian accounts in Iraq”.

Israel/Lebanon 14 November

An Israeli military spokesperson [indicated](#) that “we are operating in accordance with defensive and offensive plans [in the north]... We’ve struck a number of terrorist cells that attempted to fire at our forces with anti-tank missiles”.

Israel/Yemen 14 November

An Israeli military spokesperson [reported](#) the interception of “a rocket launched towards the territory of the State of Israel above the Red Sea, using the ‘Arrow’ long-range defense system... The target did not, at any stage, enter the territory of the State of Israel”. A Huthi spokesperson [claimed](#) that they had launched “a batch of ballistic missiles” and drones against targets in Israel, while the group’s leader [warned](#) that “our eyes are open to constantly monitor and search for any Israeli ship in the Red Sea, especially in Bab al-Mandab, and near Yemeni regional waters”.

Washington 14 November

The U.S., in coordination with the UK, [sanctioned](#) “key Hamas officials and the mechanisms by which Iran provides support to Hamas and Palestinian Islamic Jihad (PIJ)”. Secretary of State Antony Blinken [contended](#) that “Iran’s support, primarily through its Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps, enables Hamas and PIJ’s terrorist activities, including through the transfer of funds and the provision of both weapons and operational training. Iran has trained PIJ fighters to produce and develop missiles in Gaza while also funding groups that provide financial support to PIJ-affiliated fighters”.

Israel/Lebanon 13 November

Hizbollah [reported](#) targeting multiple Israeli military sites with rockets and guided missiles. In response, the Israeli military [struck](#) several Hizbollah targets, including military infrastructure, in southern Lebanon.

Updated -> Washington/Iraq/Tanf/MERV 12 November

The Pentagon [announced](#) U.S. “precision strikes... on facilities in eastern Syria used by Iran’s Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) and Iran-affiliated groups in response to continued attacks against U.S. personnel in Iraq and Syria. The strikes were conducted against a training facility and a safe house near the cities of Abu Kamal and Mayadin, respectively”. [NEW] The following day, a Pentagon official [reported](#) that the strikes were followed by four drone and rocket attacks against U.S. forces in Syria.
